

ADDITIONAL RULES FOR THE USE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

1. Sacred Heart Catholic Church does not have a license for the purpose of serving and/or selling alcoholic beverages. Therefore, the serving of any alcoholic beverages becomes the sole responsibility of and liability of the Renter. Any alcoholic beverages supplied by the Renter to guests must be served to them by a person designated to do so (i.e. bartender).
2. There cannot be any self-serve dispensers available to guests. When beer is served by means of a "tapper", the area must be under constant supervision by an adult 21 years of age or older, provided by the Renter. Alcoholic beverages will be served from behind a bar, counter or similar type fixture. Beer served from a "tapper" must be served from the kitchen serving window or in the gym.
3. **NO MINORS WILL BE ALLOWED TO DRINK OR HANDLE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES!!**
4. When alcohol is used on the Parish Hall property, the Renter is responsible to be in full and complete compliance with Federal, State, and local laws with regard to the serving and use of alcoholic beverages. Any violations of these laws are grounds for terminating the activity immediately.
5. At any activity that will allow the use of alcohol, the Renter shall hire a monitor who shall have the authority to enforce the laws of the State of Missouri with regard to the possession of alcoholic beverages and to enforce these rules and regulations or to call someone with the authority to see to their enforcement.
6. The dispensing and serving of alcoholic beverages must cease one hour before the scheduled termination of the activity.
7. No containers of alcoholic beverages may be taken outside the building.
8. The Renter must read and sign the "Alcoholic Beverage Service Contract" if alcoholic beverages are to be served.
